STORY LINES

- Coming off a thrilling 45-38 overtime win over Army, UNT is now 4-0 for just the seventh time in program history and the first time since 2018. Under third-year head coach **Eric Morris**, North Texas has a chance to start a season 5-0 for just the fourth time in program history and the first time since 1959*. (Note: UNT began the 1977 season with a 5-0 record due to a retroactively forfeited win in the first game of the season against Mississippi State. UNT originally lost 17-15.)
- North Texas received votes in both the AP and Coaches poll top-25 this week for the first time since Sept. 23, 2018.
- The Mean Green come into the contest balanced on offense and defense, ranking ninth in the country in scoring offense thanks in large part to 10 forced turnovers by the UNT defense. The 10 forced turnovers and +2.0 average turnover margin are both the best in FBS.
- Saturday's contest is the final non-conference matchup for both programs. UNT is looking to go undefeated in non-conference play for the first time since 2018.
- Under first-year DC **Skyler Cassity**, the Mean Green defense is giving up just 296.3 total yards per game (1st in American) and just 121.8 passing yards per game (11th).
- Redshirt freshman QB **Drew Mestemaker** won the starting job in the offseason despite arriving at UNT as a walkon who had not started a game at QB since ninth grade. Mestemaker has thrown 10 touchdown passes, 11th-most in country, and has a 161.6 passing efficiency rating, good for 26th in the nation. He leads all FBS freshman QBs in touchdown passes, passing efficiency and completion percentage.
- After finishing 2024 converting just 75% of red zone chances into scores, Morris' red zone offense has flipped the switch this season with 26 scores in 27 total chances. Furthermore, North Texas has scored a touchdown on 21 red zone trips, trailing only Indiana (22) for the second-most in FBS.
- UNT is outscoring teams by 27.5 points per game this season, good for 17th in FBS. Furthermore, the Mean Green have outscored opponents by 50.0 ppg at home this year (110-10), the second-best mark in the nation.
- The win over Army in OT was the second OT win for UNT this season. It is the first time in program history the Mean Green have won multiple overtime games in the same season.
- The offense has been balanced with 12 different players scoring a touchdown, tied for third in the nation. UNT had seven different players score a TD against Washington State, the most in program history.
- In the win over Western Michigan, the Mean Green came from behind for their first win after trailing by 14 or more points at any time in the 2nd half since Oct. 16, 2012 against Louisiana. It was also the first time in program history the Mean Green won a game despite not leading at any point during regulation.
- UNT had four players with double digit tackles in the win over Army for the first time since a win at Rice Oct. 20, 2021.

MORE QUICK HITTERS

- Prior to the season, HC Eric Morris named OL **Gabe Blair**, DL **Fatafehi Vailea** and P **Sawyer Evans** team captains for the 2025 season.
- The shutout in the opener vs. Lamar was the first shutout for UNT since Oct. 30, 2003 vs. Troy (21-0), first shutout in a season opener since Sept. 1, 1994 vs. ACU (48-0) and most lopsided shutout since Oct. 1, 1988 vs. E. Washington (51-0).
- The Mean Green have had eight or more players catch at least one pass in 27 of the 28 games of the Morris era, including a program record 15 different pass catchers against Washington State.
- Of the 29 games in the Morris era, 13 have seen UNT rack up 500+ yards of total offense.
- In the 17 American games in the Morris era, 11 have been decided by one score. UNT is 5-6 in those contests.
- For the second straight season, UNT was met with a large roster turnover with 68 new players on the roster in 2025, the fourth-most in FBS.
- In addition, North Texas' portal class of 51 players is the second largest in FBS. Despite this, UNT came into 2025 with 465 career NCAA games started on its roster, the most in the Morris era (2023 - 396, 2024 - 388).

SOUTH ALABAMA SERIES HISTORY

- Saturday's matchup between UNT and South Alabama will be the third meeting between the two programs.
- The Mean Green have won each of the first two contests, including a 52-38 win over the Jaguars in week one of the season in Mobile, AL., in 2024.
- In last year's contest, the two teams combined for over 1,100 yards but UNT took advantage of a blocked punt for a touchdown and got 12 catches for 230 yards and two TDs from WR Damon Ward Jr. in the win.
- The only time UNT and USA have met in Denton was in 2012 when North Texas won 24-14 thanks to 109 rushing yards by Brandin Byrd as UNT scored the final 17 points of the game to secure the win.

COMPLEMENTARY FOOTBALL

- The 4-0 start for North Texas can largely be attributed to playing complementary football on both sides of the ball. The Mean Green rank ninth in the country in scoring offense and lead the American in total defense.
- The complementary football is most evident in the turnover battle. North Texas has forced an FBS-leading
 10 turnovers and lost just two for an average turnover margin of +2.0 per game, the best mark in the country.
- Of the 10 turnovers forced by the UNT defense in 2025, the Mean Green have converted nine into scores and eight into touchdowns. On the flipside, the UNT offense has turned the ball over just twice and it has led to just three points for the opposition.
- The 59 total points scored off turnovers in 2025 for North Texas already has surpassed the total from the entirety of the 2024 and 2023 seasons. In addition, UNT is averaging 14.75 points off turnovers per game which would shatter the school record set in 2011 (9.25 PPG).
- UNT forced five turnovers in the first half against Wazzu and converted four of those turnovers into touchdowns and forced three turnovers against Army and scored three TDs off those as well.
- The last time North Texas forced five or more turnovers in a half was vs. Army on October 22, 2016.
- Redshirt freshman QB **Drew Mestemaker** has not turned the ball over through four games. According to Pro Football Focus, Mestemaker has only made one "turnover worthy" play this season.

STRONG START ON DEFENSE

- The UNT defense under first-year defensive coordinator Skyler Cassity
 has been strong in the first four games of the 2025 season, especially at
 DATCU Stadium.
- Teams have had trouble finding the end zone against the Mean Green with UNT giving up 19.5 points per game to rank 47th in FBS and fourth in the American. In home games, that number is down to just 5.0 points allowed per game, good for fifth in college football.

• After allowing 460.5 yards per game in 2024, UNT is giving up 296.3 yards per game this year (1st in American). That 164.2 yard improvement trails only Texas Tech (221.4), Mississippi State (190.9) and Arizona (190.7) as they fourth-best defensive upgrade from 2024 to 2025 in FBS.

DEFENSIVE NUGGETS

- Down the stretch against Western Michigan, the Mean Green defense stood up strong. After falling behind 27-17 with 14:13 left in the fourth, North Texas allowed a total of just four yards over WMU's final four drives of the game including the overtime period.
- Against WMU and Army, the UNT defense allowed nine yards and three total points combined in the OT periods.
- North Texas shutout an opponent for the first time in nearly 22 years in the season opener. The Mean Green blanked Lamar 51-0 for the first shutout since routing Troy 21-0 on Oct. 30, 2003.
- It was UNT's first shutout of an opponent in a season opener since a 48-0 win over ACU on Sept. 1, 1994 and the largest margin of victory in a shutout since taking down Eastern Washington 51-0 on Oct. 1, 1988.
- The Mean Green held Lamar to just 119 total yards, the fewest allowed since giving up 95 vs. ACU on Sept. 5, 1992. In addition, the 31 yards rushing yards allowed was the seventh-fewest allowed since 2000.

4-0 STARTS

- UNT heads into Saturday's contest against Army 4-0 for the first time since 2018 and just the seventh time in program history.
- A 4-0 start has signaled a successful season for the Mean Green a majority of the time with North Texas winning three conference titles (1966, 1959 and 1951) and earning two bowl berths (2018 and 1959).
- In the first six seasons of starting 4-0, the Mean Green finished a combined 46-16 with two nine-win seasons and two more eight win campaigns.
- With a win over South Alabama, UNT would move to 5-0 for the first time since 1959 and just the
 fourth time in program history. In 1977, the Mean Green began the season with a 5-0 record due to a
 retroactively forfeited win in the first game of the season against Mississippi State. UNT originally lost the
 contest 17-15.

MESTE(PLAY)MAKER

- Redshirt freshman QB **Drew Mestemaker** has had a stellar start in his first full season as a starter completing 92 of 130 passes for 1,013 yards and 10 touchdowns.
- According to Pro Football Focus, Mestemaker's 91.9 offensive grade for 2025 rates as the secondhighest among all FBS quarterbacks who have played at least 50 percent of their teams snaps.
- Mestemaker leads the American in passing TDs (10), passing efficiency (161.6) and points responsible for (66). He also sits second in completions percentage (70.8) and third in passing yards (1,103).
- With a 10-to-0 TD-to-INT ratio, Mestemaker joins Indiana's Fernando Mendoza (14-0) and Temple's Evan Simon (10-0) as one of just three FBS QBs with double digit TD passes without an interception this year.
- Among FBS freshman, Mestemaker leads the country in completion percentage and touchdown passes while sitting secodn in passing efficiency and passing yards.
- Mestemaker has thrived on passes between the hashes from 10-19 yards. In that range, his 25 completions is tied for the most in FBS where he also sits second in TD passes (6) and seventh in yards (395).

FROM ZERO TO HERO

- A former walk-on zero-star recruit, **Drew Mestemaker** served as the backup quarterback and played safety while also punting throughout his high school career at Vandegrift HS. Prior to coming to UNT, he had not started a game at QB since his freshman year in HS on the B-team in 2020.
- Through his final three years at Vandegrift, the walk-on QB served as the backup to now-Louisville QB Duece Adams in 2023 and Baylor baseball catcher Brayden Buchanan in 2022 and 2021.
- Despite the lack of recruiting pedigree, Mestemaker won the backup QB job and earned his first career start in the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl last season.
- He put in a stellar performance in the bowl game that saw him rack up 448 yards of total offense, tied for the most of any player in the 2024-25 bowl cycle. He finished 26 of 41 for 393 yards and two touchdowns while rushing nine times for 55 yards, including a 70-yard TD run.
- Mestemaker's 393 passing yards were the second-most by a QB in his starting debut since 2000 in program history while his 55 rushing yards was the fourth-most in that span.

OFFENSIVE MASTERMIND

- UNT head coach **Eric Morris** is one of the top offensive minds in the country, proven by a stellar track record over 12 seasons as an offensive coordinator and head coach.
- In each of his first two seasons at the helm, North Texas offense has ranked inside the top six in total offense (2023-6th, 2024-3rd), inside the top 12 in passing (2023-12th, 2024-4th) and inside the top 23 in scoring (2023-21st, 2024-23rd).
- Since becoming the offensive coordinator at Texas Tech in 2013 Morris has led an offense that finished inside the top 25 (FBS or FCS) in scoring nine times in 12 years.
- In addition, Morris has led offenses that finished in the top-10 in total offense nine times, including the top FBS offense (Texas Tech) in 2016 and the top FCS offense (UIW) in the nation in 2020.
- Morris-led offenses have been dominant through the air as eight of Morris' first 12 years as an OC or HC have resulted in a top-five passing offense in the country.
- In Morris' 29 games as head coach at North Texas, the offense has eclipsed 500 yards on 13 occasions, including six times in 2024, the second-most of any head coach in UNT history (Seth Littrell, 23 in 88 games).
- For perspective, North Texas had just 20 games with 500+ yards of total offense in the five seasons prior to Morris' arrival. UNT is 9-4 when surpassing 500 yards of offense under Morris.

GET IN THE ZONE

- After finishing 2024 converting just 75 percent of red zone chances into scores (119th in FBS), the UNT red zone offense has flipped the switch this season with 26 scores in 27 total chances (96.3%, 20th in FBS).
- North Texas has scored a touchdown on 21 of 27 red zone trips, the second-most in FBS.
- Against Washington State, UNT finished a perfect 9-for-9 in the redzone including eight red zone TDs.
- UNT's 96.3 percent score rate is the best among teams who have been inside the red zone 21+ times.

DOMINANT AT THE DAT

- North Texas has been dominant in its two games at DATCU Stadium this season taking down Washington State 59-10 and shutting out Lamar 51-0.
- The 51 and 49-point wins over Wazzu were the third and fourth-largest margins of victory for UNT in the FBS era (since 1995) trailing only a 74-point win vs. Nicholls (2014) and a 52-point win vs. Middle Tennessee (2011).
- UNT is averaging 55.0 points per game while giving up just 5.0, outscoring opponents 110-10. The +50 average scoring margin in home games is the second-best mark in the nation.
- North Texas forced five turnovers in the first half against the Cougars. It was the first time UNT forced 5+ turnovers in a half since October 22, 2016 vs. Army and the most forced turnovers in a game since Sept. 15, 2018 when they knocked off Arkansas.

SPREAD THE WEALTH

- North Texas has a pleathora of options in the passing game this season with 17 different players recording at least once catch, tied for the fifth-most in FBS.
- Four different players, **Wyatt Young**, **Cameron Dorner**, **Miles Coleman** and **Landon Sides** have 100+ receiving yards and 10+ receptions. The quartet has combined for 55 catches, 685 yards and six TDs.
- The Mean Green also added veteran transfer pass catchers **Simeon Evans** (Sam Houston) and TE **Tre Williams III** (Limestone). Evans earned Honorable Mention All-CUSA honors last season while Williams was a DII All-American and has shown his value with a pair of TDs through four games in 2025.
- The Mean Green have had eight or more players catch at least one pass in 28 of the 29 games of the Eric Morris era and set a school record with 15 different pass catchers in the win over Wazzu.
- The offense has been balanced overall as well with 12 different players scoring a touchdown trailing only USC and Vanderbilt for third in the nation.
- UNT had seven different players score a touchdown against Washington St., the most in program history.

THE HAWK HAS LANDED

- Freshman RB **Caleb Hawkins** broke out in a big way in the win over Army, rushing 13 times for 99 yards and four touchdowns, including the game-winning score in overtime.
- Hawkins joined Lance Dunbar, Jamario Thomas, Patrick Cobbs and Scott Davis as just the fifth player in program history to rush for four TDs in a game. Of that list, only Hawkins and Thomas (2004) are freshmen.
- Hawkins earned American Conference Offensive Player of the Week honors for his efforts against the Black Knights and has now rushed 26 times for 167 yards and five TDs on the year.

ALL HE DOES IS SCORE TOUCHDOWNS

- Sophomore RB **Makenzie McGill II** has proven to have a nose for the endzone as he is up to 14 rushing touchdowns in his career through 17 games played.
- McGill II has scored a rushing touchdown in seven consecutive games, tied for the third-longest active streak of games with a rushing touchdown among FBS players.
- McGill, who logged 100+ rushing yards in road wins over WMU and Army, is the only returning running back in the American who logged double-digit rushing TDs in 2024.
- The sophomore RB has picked up right where he left off, scoring a rushing touchdown in each of the first four games of 2025, including the game-winner in OT against WMU. McGill's 14 touchdowns in the last two seasons are the most among non-P4 running backs in that span.
- McGill is one of only 11 RBs who had 10+ rushing TDs to return to the team he played for in 2024 along with Notre Dame's Jeremiah Love, Penn State's Nick Singleton and Texas A&M's Le'Veon Moss among others. He joins San Jose State's Floyd Chalk IV as one of only two non-power 4 RBs to stake that claim.

AMERICAN CONFERENCE DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- LB **Shane Whitter** spearheaded a dominant defensive effort for in the win over Washington State and was named the American Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 15.
- The senior LB from Burlington, North Carolina, is the first UNT player to earn Defensive Player of the Week honors since the program joined the American prior to the 2023 season.
- In the rout of the Cougars, Whitter led the defense with a game-high eight tackles, including five solo stops, a tackle for loss and his first career interception that he returned 43 yards to the Washington State 12-yard line to set up a Mean Green touchdown. He also had a QB hurry on the Cougars' first drive of the game that led to an errant throw and an **Evan Jackson** interception to help put UNT up 14-0 early.
- Through four games, Whitter leads the team in tackles (38) and ranks fourth in the American in solo stops (18).

- Among the 136 FBS schools, Mestemaker was one of only 11 starting quarterbacks from the 2024 recruiting class won the starting QB job for the season opener in 2025.
- Of those 11 starters, eight were ranked inside the top 25 QBs in the class by 247.
- In addition, Mestemaker is the only one of that group to not be ranked by any of the major services and the only former walk on to earn the starting job.

SKY'S THE LIMIT

- In the offseason, North Texas brought in Defensive Coordinator **Skyler Cassity** after a successful one-year stint in the same role at Sam Houston.
- In 2024, Cassity led Sam Houston's 11th-ranked pass defense while forcing 22 turnovers, the 16th-most in FBS in 2024. The Bearkats were also one of only four Group of Five teams to give up 20.0 points per game or less last season.
- Upon arrival at Sam Houston, Cassity inherited a 3-9 defense which he immediately turned into a 9-3 team for 2024. The program became bowl eligible for the first time.
- The Bearkats ranked eighth in possession stop rate at 73.8%, 14th in red zone defense and 12th fourth-down defense. In CUSA, Cassity's defense was top five in every category and led the league in scoring defense, passing defense, passing defense, passing defense.
- Prior to Sam Houston, Cassity spent two seasons, 2022-23, as Abilene Christian's defensive coordinator.

QUARTERBACK WHISPERER

- UNT head coach Eric Morris has had a knack for finding under-the-radar talent at the quarterback position and turning them into elite players at their position.
- In his time coaching, Morris has had the opportunity to recruit and mentor future NFL quarterbacks **Case Keenum** (Houston, 2010-11), **Baker Mayfield** (Texas Tech, 2013), **Davis Webb** (Texas Tech, 2013-15), **Patrick Mahomes** (Texas Tech, 2014-16) and **Cam Ward** (UIW, 2020-21)
- Of the top quarterbacks listed above, none of them were ranked higher than a three star as a recruit by any of the major services, highlighted by providing the only collegiate offer to Heisman finalist and future 2025 NFL No. 1 overall pick Cam Ward.
- Also of note, when Morris was the offensive coordinator at Washington State he extended the only P4 offer to now Oklahoma QB and Heisman Trophy candidate John Mateer out of High School.

MESTIE'S BESTIE

- Starting QB **Drew Mestemaker** and WR **Miles Coleman** have had a connection going back to their respective youth leagues when they played together in Austin, Texas.
- The duo continued the friendship on and off the field into high school where they played together at Vandegrift HS in Northwest Austin, Texas. Their senior year in 2023, the Vipers went 10-0 in the regular season and won the 6A District 25 title.
- Now together on the field in college, Coleman and Mestemaker have continued that connection. In five games with Mestemaker as the starting QB, they have combined for 25 completions for 286 yards and a touchdown.

BEARKATS MEAN GREEN

- In addition to a new defensive staff, Cassity also helped bring seven players from Sam Houston in the transfer portal, six of which are on the defensive side of the ball.
- The defensive additions are CB **Da'Veawn Armstead**, LB **S'Maje Burrell**, LB **Trey Fields**, CB **David Fisher**, DL **Briceon Hayes** and DL **Richard Outland Jr.** who have all been strong contributers to the UNT defense this season.
- All seven additions appear on the two-deep while Fields, Outland, Hayes, Fisher and Evans all started in the contest against Army.
- Fields serves as the quarterback of the defense after starting 12 games at linebacker for the Bearkats in 2024. The senior out of Danciger, Texas, is third on the team with 26 tackles and has also added two TFLs, an interception and a forced fumbles this season.
- In the secondary, Fisher and Armstead were the starting corners for 11 of Sam Houston's 13 games. The duo has combined for 16 tackles, a TFL, an INT, a forced fumble and a pair of PBUs on the year.
- Along the defensive front, Outland Jr. started 11 games in 2024 and was a space stuffer in the middle with 5.5 TFLs and 3.0 sacks. He added another TFL against Lamar in his first game in a UNT uniform.
- Offensively, Evans has caught nine passes for 97 yards while also serving as the primary kick returner.
- In total, the seven transfers from Sam Houston have combined for 245 games played with 97 combined starts.

LINEBACKER CORE

- The Mean Green LB room is having a breakout season with the return of senior **Shane Whitter** and junior **Ethan Wesloski** along with the addition of senior transfer **Trey Fields.** The trio sit first, second and third on the team in tackles this season.
- Wesloski has been stellar with 27 tackles and a team-high 5.0 tackles for loss (t-3rd in the American) He had the biggest play of the night against Lamar when he produced a TFL, forced a fumble and recovered it in the endzone for UNT's first defensive touchdown since 2022.
- Fields has racked up 26 tackles, 2.0 TFLs, an interception and a forced fumble on the year. Fields is the quarterback of the defense and wears the helmet communication with DC Skyler Cassity on gameday.
- Whitter, meanwhile, leads the team with 36 tackles and has added an INT and a fumble recovery. The senior transfer from Oklahoma has 31 tackles in the last three games for the Mean Green.

KICKIN' IT WITH KALI

- Sophomore K Kali Nguma has had a strong start to his UNT career kicking for the Mean Green.
- · Last season, Nguma went 11 for 16 in field goals with a long of 46 yards and matched a school record

by going a perfect 55 for 55 in extra points. He has hit all four of his FG attempts this season, including a 25-yarder that tied the game with less than two minutes left against WMU to send the contest to OT.

- Nguma has started a perfect 23-for-23 in XPs this season to push his career total to 78, good for sixthmost in program history.
- In the extra point category, UNT kickers have still not missed a PAT in two seasons under Eric Morris.

GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

- As they have been throughout Eric Morris' tenure, the Mean Green have excelled in the classroom.
- In the spring 2025 semester, UNT posted a team GPA of 3.252. It was the second-highest semester GPA in program history and the highest spring semester team GPA in program history.
- Additionally, 15 players have on the roster have already received their college degrees.
- Simeon Evans has been a standout in the classroom with a 3.82 cumulative GPA and earned the honor of being named UNT's nominee for the prestigious Campbell Trophy, given each year to the FBS player who stands out the most in both the classroom and on the field.

MAKING NOISE IN THE HUDDLE(STON)

- Sophomore transfer DL Keviyan Huddleston has started his UNT career in a big way with 2.5 sacks, 4.0 TFLs and a fumble recovery in four games in a Mean Green uniform.
- A transfer from TCU, half of Huddleston's eight tackles on the year have been for losses while his 2.5 sacks is tied for fifth in the American.
- In the last two games vs. Wazzu and Army, Huddleston has seen an uptick in playing time and has delivered with six tackles, 3.0 TFLs, 2.0 sacks and a fumble recovery.

NARROW MARGINS IN THE AMERICAN

- UNT has become synonymous with close games during American play in their first two years in the league.
- In the first 17 league games in the American for the Mean Green, 11 of those contests have been decided by one score. UNT is now 5-6 in those games after knocking off Army 45-38 in the conference opener. The Mean Green went 2-2 in one-score games in 2024 after finishing 2-4 in 2023.
- The 2023 schedule, Morris' first season at UNT, was littered with close matchups as it finished with eight games decided by one score or less, matching a program record for one-score games set in 1937.
- In total, the Mean Green have played 15 one-score games in less than three years under Coach Morris. UNT is 7-8 in those contests, but a perfect 2-0 this season.

NEW FACES EVERYWHERE

- UNT has 68 new players on the roster, trailing only Utah State, New Mexico and West Virginia for the fourth-most in all of FBS.
- A significant majority of those newcomers arrived via the transfer portal with North Texas adding 51 transfer prospects in the offseason, the second-most in the country.
- The new players on the roster do not lack playing time, however, with 29 of them having playing in at least 10 NCAA contests in their careers.
- The portal prospects are littered throughout the two-deep. In total, 30 (18 defense, 12 offense) of the 54 offensive and defensive players on the two deep are players that arrived via the portal this offseason.

STONE COLD CELEBRATION

- Starting in 2023, when the defense creates a turnover a "Stone Cold" celebration begins on the sidelines.
- In honor of WWE Superstar Steve Austin, who played linebacker and defensive end at North Texas in the 1980s, players bang together two bottles of water while holding a wrestling belt to mimic the famous celebration of "Stone Cold" Steve Austin.
- In the 2024 win over SFA, a video of Ridge Texada's interception celebration generated over 7.2 million views on social media over the first 24 hours after posting. "And that's the bottom line."

ON THE NATIONAL STAGE

- The 2024 season put North Texas on the national stage in a way never seen before in program history.
- The Mean Green played seven of their 13 games on linear TV a season ago, including being featured on ESPN for the First Responder Bowl. The previous record for most linear broadcasts for the Mean Green was five set in 2023.
- UNT also played back-to-back home games on ESPN2 against Tulane and Army last season, marking the first two ESPN2 broadcasts in DATCU Stadium history.
- The trend looks to continue in 2025 as five of the seven scheduled broadcasts in 2025 are on linear networks, including Saturday's contest against South Alabama on ESPNU.

BIG MEN UP FRONT

- After starting 10 different offensive line combinations in 13 games a season ago, North Texas has solidified the OL in 2025 with Braydon Nelson, Tay Yanta, Johnny Dickson III, and Gabe Blair all having played 240+ snaps through four games.
- · Blair is the leader up front. After missing the 2024 season due to injury, Blair is back to his strong play with the fifth-best OL passing blocking grade in the American according to PFF. The 2023 Second Team All-American Conference selection has started 40 straight games on the offensive line in his career.
- At tackle, Nelson leads the way after a stellar freshman campaign that landed him on the PFF All-True Freshman team in 2024. Through four games, Nelson's 70.2 overall offensive grade is sixth in the American and he has allowed just three total pressures.
- · Yanta and Dickson, meanwhile, have been steady leaders in the interior with 255 total snaps apiece this season, all at C and RG, respectively.
- Also starting on the OL is Kent State transfer Jimto Obidegwu at RT who has been stellar even while fighting through injury. On his 96 snaps, Obidegwu has a 76.5 overall offensive PFF grade and has now allowed a sack or a QB pressure this season.
- The UNT offensive line came into 2025 ranked inside the top 11 in FBS in combined games played (t-11th, 227) games played and games started (t-10th, 135).



POSTGAME NOTES

- The Mean Green defense posted the program's first shutout in over two decades in a 51-0 victory in the season opener against Lamar at DATCU Stadium on Saturday night.
- UNT last blanked an opponent on Oct. 30, 2003, when the Mean Green won 21-0 versus Troy at its previous home stadium Fouts Field.
- On Saturday, the defense held the Trojans to 119 yards of total offense, including 31 rushing yards, which is tied for the seventh-fewest allowed by the Mean Green since 2000.
- Junior linebacker Ethan Wesloski recorded seven tackles including two solo stops, two tackles-for-loss, a half-sack, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery for a touchdown.
- Junior defensive lineman Ethan Day tallied a career-high five tackles, including two solo stops, and his first career sack while senior linebacker Trey Fields registered four tackles, one TFL and his first career interception.
- In his second career start, redshirt freshman quarterback Drew Mestemaker finished 24-for-32 with 329 yards, three passing touchdowns and one rushing score.
- Senior wide receiver Cameron Dorner posted a team-high seven catches for 98 yards and a touchdown while sophomore Wyatt Young caught four balls for 97 yards and two touchdowns, each career-high marks.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Makenzie McGill II rushed for a game-winning touchdown as UNT captured a 33-30 overtime victory over Western Michigan at Waldo Stadium on Saturday.
- The win marked the program's first overtime victory since Oct. 30, 2021, and its first-ever win in which the Mean Green never held a lead in regulation.
- UNT overcame a 24-10 third quarter deficit marking the second 14-point comeback under head coach Eric Morris, first since Nov. 25, 2023, versus UAB.
- McGill II finished the day with 102 yards on 16 carries and one touchdown, his second career 100-yard rushing game.
- Redshirt freshman quarterback Drew Mestemaker finished 18-of-33 for 224 yards passing and two touchdowns while adding 24 yards rushing.
- Through the first two games of the season, UNT's defense has allowed 30 total points which marks the fewest for the Mean Green since 2002.
- Shane Whitter (12), Trey Fields (11) and Patrick Smith-Young (11) each finished with double-digit tackles, becoming the first trio since Dec. 2, 2022, to accomplish the feat.
- Junior linebacker Ethan Wesloski tallied eight total tackles as he matched his career-high mark of 2.0 tackles-for-loss.
- Sophomore kicker Kali Nguma finished 2-for-2 on field goal attempts, including the game-tying, 25-yard kick with 1:34 remaining in the fourth quarter.

POSTGAME NOTES

- UNT defeated Washington State 59-10 on Saturday at DATCU Stadium, marking the first 3-0 start since 2018 and eight times overall in program history.
- Redshirt freshman guarterback Drew Mestemaker finished 24-of-29 for 211 yards passing and four touchdowns through the air.
- UNT had 15 players catch at least one pass in the game which is the highest mark since at least 1995 and ties East Carolina (vs. Campbell) for the most for any FBS team this season.
- The Mean Green tallied four rushing touchdowns including two from junior RB Jayden Becks, one from sophomore RB Makenzie McGill II and one from freshman RB Caleb Hawkins.
- This season, UNT's defense has allowed 40 total points which is the fewest points the program has allowed through the first three games of a season since the 1984 team held opponents to 37 points over the same span.
- UNT forced five turnovers all in the first half, marking the first time they have forced five turnovers in a game since Sept. 15, 2018, at Arkansas, and the first time forcing five in a half since Oct. 22, 2016, against Army (second half).

- Freshman running back Caleb Hawkins rushed for four touchdowns as the Mean Green captured a 45-38 overtime road win over the Army Black Knights on Saturday afternoon at Michie Stadium.
- · Hawkins tied the single-game program record with his four-score rushing effort and became only the second UNT freshman to tally 24 points scored, joining Jamario Thomas (2004).
- In total, North Texas scored five rushing touchdowns with four from Hawkins and one from sophomore running back Makenzie McGill II. This marked the first time UNT has had four or more rushing touchdowns in back-to-back games since 2021.
- Redshirt freshman guarterback Drew Mestemaker finished 26-of-36 for 249 yards passing and a touchdown through the air.
- The Mean Green defense forced three turnovers with fumble recoveries from DL Keviyan Huddleston and DB Will Jones II along with one interception from CB De'Veawn Armstead.
